This plant hadn't bloomed in two or three years. The leaves were dry and some suffered from *chlorosis*. After adding (a few weeks ago) about 1 tablespoon of Montmorillonite clay containing



trace elements organically chelated by fulvic and humic acids, look what happened in the dead of the Winter!
